2010 ALTAMURA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

On the heels of the 2007 Altamura Cabernet garnering the #5 position in Wine Spectator's TOP 100 of 2010, and the 2009 Cabernet being awarded the #92 spot in the TOP 100 list of 2012, the 2010 release is very similar style-wise, richer in texture, and in Frank's opinion, our best effort to date.

For over 20 years Altamura has been quietly and consistently producing exquisite Cabernet Sauvignon from the Wooden Valley area of Napa.

Entirely estate grown, this wine is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon and aged in French oak for 30 months. 14.8% alc/vol.
