Winemaker Notes: Winemaker/Owner Frank Altamura says:

"The 2010 vintage in the Wooden Valley area of Napa has unique characteristics that differ from valley floor fruit. The higher altitude (700 – 1,000) on our ranch provides a cooler growing season than those in the lowlands. Our rocky soils naturally provide great drainage, and we left our grapes out longer than many other vineyards, and picked after the October rains. As a result we saw dense color and bright fruit."
