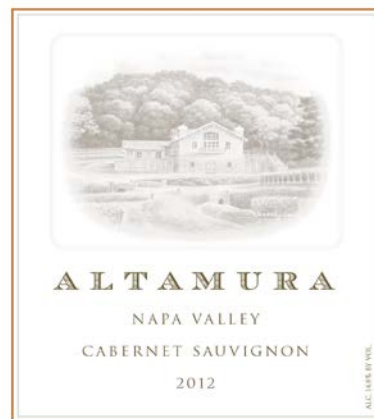


# Wine Spectator
